

CCSF Mini-Grant/Headphones

In January, 2017 the CCSF awarded a \$500.00 mini-grant to purchase headphones for fourth grade students at CES. One hundred and six headphones were purchased and arrived in late January.

February 1st teachers met during CT time to unpack the HP-200 Stereo Headphones. It was decided to assign chrome books and headphones according to each student's classroom number. Therefore, if a student's classroom number is 3 he/she uses the corresponding headphones labeled 3. This would allow teachers to keep track of students' care of headphones. Labeled headphones are stored in a sturdy box labeled "4th grade" on the chrome book cart they stay with. Teachers provided a mini lesson to their classes on proper use and storage of headphones.

Headphone Use

Students have been able to use these headphones on a daily basis in all subject areas. Differentiation and independent work have allowed teachers to work in small groups with struggling students. In social studies and science teachers have assigned a Brainpop episode, an Ohio Studies Weekly newspaper, or a Study Jams video. Students have also been working independently on social studies modules on the district website as a review for the state AIR test. Language arts students use the headphones for Google Read and Write and assignments on Google Classroom. Math classes utilize headphones with the Pearson Math series. All lessons can be completed on-line.
